- This position reports to the Grammar School and Logic School Department Heads
- A Bachelor's Degree is required for faculty positions
- Teaching experience, classical training, and advanced education are desired but not required
- Faculty and staff are expected to demonstrate high moral character and to embrace the virtues upheld and developed in a classical education
- Exhibiting a sense of humility and desire to grow and improve as a teacher of the classical, liberal arts tradition, faculty will seek out and accept opportunities to develop their skills through professional development and engagement in the wider classical education community
- All faculty will exhibit and uphold the Oakdale Academy Staff Honor Code, Statement of Faith, and other school policies
- Teaching positions begin August 1 and are contracted through end of July, with on-campus responsibilities from mid-August to early June
