Students rising to grades K-2 will need to read a specific number of minutes each month in June, July and August to qualify for the reading reward at the beginning of the year.

For students moving into grades 3 and 4, students will select books from the attached list of books to read throughout the summer. Students rising to grades 3 and 4 will need to read a specific number of minutes each month in June, July and August, and must provide a highlighted version of the attached book list to show which books were selected for reading to qualify for the reading reward at the beginning of the year. Students should read at grade level or above.

Successful completion and the return of required paperwork **by Thursday, August 29th**, qualifies students to receive the gift of a book selected by Oakdale for the purpose of helping students to begin their own personal library of treasured books.
