



BACKGROUND CHECK PROCEDURE FOR ALL OA VOLUNTEERS

All volunteers of Oakdale Academy are subject to completing a background check through the Michigan State Police ICHAT tool before being approved to volunteer at Oakdale Academy. Please submit a completed form at least 5 business days prior to date of volunteer work.

What is an ICHAT Background Check?

ICCHAT stands for: Internet Criminal History Access Tool. This is a search of public criminal history records through the Michigan State Police. More at:

What shows up on an ICHAT Background Check?

All convicted felonies and serious misdemeanors (exceeding 93 days punishable) that are reported to all 83 counties of the state of Michigan.

What does NOT show up on an ICHAT Background Check?

ICCHAT does not provide access to suppressed records, warrant information, federal records, tribal records, traffic records, juvenile records or local misdemeanors. Criminal history from other states is also not given.
