Graduation Requirements

## General Requirements

Oakdale Academy offers two diploma options and one certificate option for students, as outlined below.

In pursuit of any of the diploma or certificate options, all students must meet these general requirements for the awarding of a diploma or certificate:

- Minimum GPA of C- (1.67) (4.0 scale) in all math and all foreign language classes taken in the Rhetoric School at Oakdale Academy in order to move on to the next level.
- Must complete at a minimum Algebra 2, Latin 2, and Statesmanship.
- Minimum overall/cumulative GPA of 2.25 (4.0 scale) for classes taken in the Rhetoric School at Oakdale Academy.
- Fulfillment of courses prescribed in the Classical Core Academic Program.
- Accordance with all policies, statements, etc. of Oakdale Academy and with the Oakdale Academy Honor Code.


## Classical Studies Diploma

For the Classical Studies Diploma, students must take all required courses in the Classical Core Academic Program and meet all General Requirements listed above.

## Associate Diploma

Students will be enrolled automatically in pursuit of the Associate Diploma if they matriculate full-time to Oakdale Academy after Ninth Grade (i.e., grades 10, 11, and 12).

Classes taken before admittance to Oakdale Academy will be considered for placement purposes only and not for credit.

Students will follow the pro-rated requirements of the Classical Core Academic Program outlined above., based on their year of entry to Oakdale Academy and prior classes taken (with transcript confirmation). Students must also meet all General Requirements listed above.

## Homeschool Certificate

The following minimum credits are required for all students pursuing a Homeschool Certificate from Oakdale Academy.

Students must be enrolled in Grade 12 for at least one core academic class and successfully complete and pass a minimum of five total classes in the Core Academic Program in the Rhetoric School and meet all General Requirements listed above.

## Enrollment Requirements for the Rhetoric School (grades 9-12)

Rhetoric School (grades 9-12) students at Oakdale Academy follow the Classical Core Academic Program in keeping with our mission.

Full-time students pursuing one of the diploma programs must have a full schedule, meaning they must have enrolled in six core classes and two elective courses and attend the entire school day.

To be awarded one of the diplomas or the Homeschool Certificate, a student must maintain a C - (1.67) (4.0 scale) or better in all mathematics and foreign language courses and a student must maintain an overall cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.25 (4.0 scale).

During initial enrollment in the Rhetoric School, parents will choose in writing which diploma, or certificate track their child(ren) is pursuing under these conditions:

N.B. Parents may elect, in writing, to have their student move from one of the diploma tracks to the Homeschool Certificate track, but a student may not be enrolled full time.
N.B. Students enrolled at Oakdale Academy in Grade 8 and moving to Grade 9 will automatically be enrolled in the Classical Studies Diploma.

## Classical Core Academic Program

Classes listed below meet the requirements for both diplomas and the Homeschool Certificate. The Classical Core Academic Program must be completed in the Rhetoric School (grades 9-12).

Four years of the following classes:

- Mathematics
- Science
- Literature
- Classical Studies
- History
- Ancient Language(s)

Two choices per year among the following classes:

- Music*
- Art*
- Yearbook
- Physical Education*
- Drama (if offered as a class)
- Other classes as may be offered
*N.B. Students are required to take one year each of Music, Art, and Physical Education.
